Trap League Rules

Trap Leagues at East Monongahela Sportsmen Club run for approximately 10 weeks.

The league is scored with an overall top-gun winner followed up by a Lewis style scoring system for the remaining shooters.

The first round of trap for a league shooter is their league score for that week.

A shooter can either make up or shoot ahead only one score, once per week, on top of their weekly shoot score. For example, if it is week 3, week 2 can be made up in addition with your week 3 score. This additional score will be the shooters second scored round that week.

All shooters in the league will shoot 5 rounds of trap for score, at both trap houses over the course of the 10 week league. 5 scoreable rounds at each house will prevent any one shooter from not shooting at either house in a fair manner, as well as to ensure an even scoring field.

Any shotgun gauge, model or action are welcome.

Trap league fees are non-refundable.
