.22 Precision Rifle Intro Day/Short Match
Sunday May 19, 2024 – 9:00 AM

Several members have expressed interest in learning more about how PRS works and some of the equipment involved. Right now, EMSC does not offer organized shoots in this discipline. **On May 19th, that will change!**

The purpose of this day is to help shooters learn about this sport and try out their equipment and skills in this challenging game.

What to Expect:

This game involves shooting .22 rifles with scopes from various props at steel targets in many different sizes and shapes placed at known (but many) distances.

We will have 5 stages to try with a few props and we will use larger than normal targets to make sure all have a good time. You should expect to have to adjust your scope or hold over targets while shooting from various props such as a tank trap, drum/wheel or a barricade.

What you need to participate:

1. Eye and ear protection (mandatory).
2. A positive attitude and some patience – This is new to many (mandatory).
3. .22 rifle with a scope (adjustable with external knobs is helpful).
4. At least 100 rounds of ammo – the short match will be 50 shots, but you will want to practice and get some scope settings.
5. Bipod and support bags are helpful but not required (there will be equipment to borrow).



Sight-In will begin on the rifle range at 8:00 AM, there will be time to help you get information (speeds) to figure out your scope adjustments for the different target distances. This shoot is all about learning and teaching this game – the scores will be kept but that is not the focus!

Full course of fire will be emailed to all registered participants prior to the event. You have to be ready to start @ 9:00 AM – no late entries can be accepted.
